Larry's Homemade Pizza

Bisquick Biscuit Mix and Milk

1 lb. Ground Beef

1 lb. Sausage

1 Onion, chopped

1 Bell Pepper, chopped

1 jar Mushrooms

1 lb. Cheddar Cheese, shredded

1lb. Mozzarella Cheese, shredded

Tomato Sauce

Brown ground beef and sausage with onion, bell pepper and mushrooms. Mix enough Bisquick Biscuit mix and milk to make dough to cover a 13 x 9 sheet pan. Spread dough in pan, to cover completely. Spread dough with tomato sauce. Layer 1/3 of meat mixture on biscuits, then 1/3 of cheese. Do this 2 more times till all ingredients are used, ending with the cheese. Bake in a 350 degree oven for 25—30 minutes until crust is browned.
