### Freeze Warning Instructions

We have had a few nights where the temperature has dropped below the freezing mark. We will, more than likely, have more of these temperatures before the winter is over. Therefore, we wanted to provide you

with our recommendations for the preparation of these nights.

1. Open cupboard doors under faucets; and
2. Drip a faucet or disconnect the water hose so pres-

sure is relieved in the line.

We have already had a few faucets crack due to the cold temperatures but have been able to replace them immediately.

Whenever we know

that the temperature is going to drop below freezing, we will post the Freeze Warning on our sign at the entrance. As always, please call us if you have any problems concerning the freeze warnings or, anything else that may arise. We are here to help.

dle everything that a regular sewer system encounters. Please do not flush any items, such as feminine hygiene products through our sewer

system. Our system can not tolerate this type of waste and will lead to more problems with our sewage lift system. Please advise any of your guests, as needed.

We also feel the need to advise you that the toilet paper provided in our restrooms is not compatible with RV guidelines. As we have had a few rolls taken out of the restrooms, it is important that you know that it does not disintegrate in the manner required for RV use.

## Updates to Regulations and Reminders

We have changed our hours on the Activity Center at the front of the property. It will now be closed everyday at 6:00 p.m. in order for our employees to close it up on their way home.

There is a Lost & Found located in the Office. If you have lost something or found something, please bring it to the Office and we will try to get it back to the rightful owner.
