Keypad Code

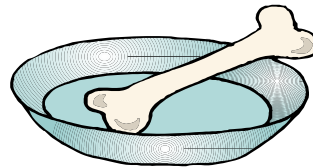
On November 2, 2010, at approximately 1:00 p.m., we will change our bathroom/laundry codes. The new code will be **4637**.

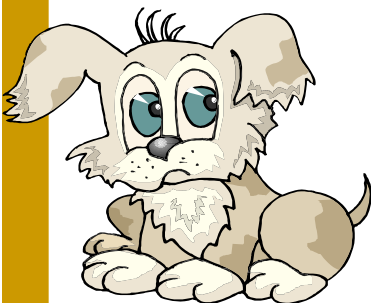

Pet Etiquette in the Park

at the park. This way everyone is happy. A few that need to be reiterated are:

- All dogs must be on a leash. We know that all our dogs in the park are well behaved but we ask that all of them be put on a leash when they are outside.
- The owners must be home if they are going to tie the dog outside. This alleviates the possibility of the dog barking excessively.
- Please clean up after your pets and utilize our dog runs instead of other guest's yards.
